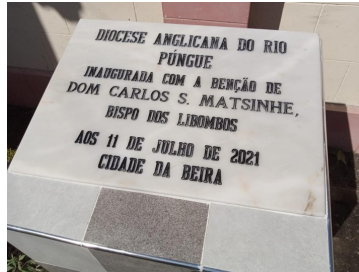

The first Synod has already approved the elevation of the Missionary Diocese of Nampula to Full Diocese and Bishop Manuel Ernesto from Missionary to Diocesan Bishop. Bishop André Soares is the Dean of the Province & Bishop Carlos Matsinhe is the Acting Presiding Bishop.
